Students will develop the knowledge and skills to work for tribes or in collaboration with tribes, and will connect what they learn from the Program to their tribes, communities, and leadership positions. Students will develop foundational knowledge to encourage or enhance post-secondary education and other opportunities.

Topics include: California Indian History, Tribal Sovereignty, Federal Indian Law & Policy, Historical Trauma, PL-280, Tribal-State Relations, Robert's Rules of Order, a Tribal Leader Panel, and more!
